This refers to advertisement No. 1-04/2023-Estt- I(RCT) published by Recruitment Cell in the newspapers as well as uploaded on the Institute website <u>www.aiims.edu</u> and AIIMS website <u>www.aiimsexams.ac.in</u> for filling up of various Group 'A' (Non-Faculty), 'B' & 'C' posts at AIIMS, New Delhi/ NCI Jhajjar, Haryana.

The CBT Examination for the said post was conducted on 27.08.2023 and accordingly the result of CBT Examination was declared vide Result Notification no.175/2023 dated 14.09.2023. The important details related to Skill Test (Stenographic Test) for the said post are as under:

## Note:

\* Computation of marks from the Shorthand is essentially marked in terms of 0% mistakes. A universal criterion of 5% mistake is generally taken as cut-off for qualifying. But in this exam this has to be converted to marks. Therefore, 5% mistakes will be equated with 40% marks (usual qualifying marks in examination) i.e. those who make 5% mistakes will be given 40% of 100 (40 marks). For every 1% less mistakes an additional 12 marks be added to 40 in such a manner that those who make 0% mistake will be full marks (100).

9.	Preparation of Merit List	Final Merit List will be based upon Stage-I CBT Examination provided the candidate should be qualified in Stage-II i.e. Skill Test (Stenographic test)
10.	Resolution of Tie Cases	<ul> <li>In cases where more than one candidate secures equal MARKS, tie will be resolved</li> <li>(i) Accuracy in Stenographic test [candidates with higher accuracy will be placed above those with lower accuracy].</li> <li>ii) In case ties are not resolved, date of birth shall be used [candidates who are older / born earlier will be placed above candidates who are younger / born later].</li> </ul>

Important Note:

I. Candidate is required to bring the Stage-II admit card which will be uploaded on the website on  $-10^{th}$  October, 2023 (Tuesday) on the day of Skill Test alongwith one govt. approved original ID proof described on the admit card.

II. The candidates are advised to download their Admit Cards from website <u>www.aiimsexams.ac.in</u>. Only website generated Admit Cards will be treated authentic and permissible to appear in the said Examination. No Admit card will be sent by Speed post.

III. The original documents of all selected candidates related to fulfilment of eligibility criteria, experience etc. will be verified by the Recruitment Cell before final appointment.

IV. All candidates are required to choose their stenographic language (English/Hindi) using the link provided at their MyPage by login with credentials.

All applicants are required to visit the website regularly as all subsequent Corrigendum / Addendum / Updates will only be uploaded on the Website.
