The qualifying marks in Recruitment Examination will be: ➤ 50% for UR ➤ 45% for OBC ➤ 40% for ST For PWBD 5% relaxation will be given irrespective of the category ( <i>as per post advertised in the advertisement</i> ). Syllabus of Examination	The syllabus will be in accordance with education qualification and experience as mentioned in the advertisement.
Resolution of Tie Cases	In cases where more than one candidate secures equal MARKS, tie will be resolved (i) First by using date of birth with older candidates placed higher. ii) If not resolved by (i), the number of wrong answers / negative marks will be used wherein those with less wrong answers / negative marks will be placed higher.

Hence, the candidate will be allowed **PROVISIONALLY** to appear in the Online (CBT) Recruitment Examination.
