**1.1 Overview of Scheme of Examination:**

- (i) The Examination and Evaluation will be in three stages-
- (ii) **Stage-I:** Online(CBT) mode Theory Examination with minimum qualifying marks for eligible to be appear in the Stage-II Examinations
- (iii) **Stage-II:** Physical Standards Test (PET) with minimum qualifying physical eligibility parameters to appear in the Stage-III Examination.
- (iv) **Stage-III:** Physical Efficiency Test (PET) with marks of minimum qualifying physical fitness parameters.

**1.2 Online (CBT) mode Theory Examination (Stage-I)**

**1.2.1 Nature of Examination**

This will be an eligibility examination for appearing in Stage-II, Stage-III and for preparing merit list.

**1.2.2 Language and mode of Examination**

The Language of Examination will be English and Hindi. Questions will appear on the screen and answers are to be clicked with the help of a mouse only.

**1.2.3 Duration of Examination and Number of Questions:**

One and half hours (90 minutes), 100 MCQs

**1.2.4. Number of Papers for Stage-I Examination**

**a. Type of Questions in Paper I:**

Objective Type: Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) of Single Response Type (One response out of four)

- (i) General Intelligence and Reasoning,
- (ii) General Awareness and Professional Knowledge,

- (iii) Quantitative Aptitude and Ability,
- (iv) English and Hindi Language and Comprehension

**b. Division of Questions and Marks Distribution for Paper I:**

MCQ of 100 questions of 100 marks (90 Minutes)

- (i) General Intelligence and Reasoning (25 MCQs/25 marks)
- (ii) Quantitative Aptitude and Ability (25 MCQs/25 marks)
- (iii) General Awareness & Professional Knowledge (30 MCQs/30 marks)
- (iv) English and Hindi Language and Comprehension (20 MCQs/20 marks)

**c. Syllabus for Paper I:**

The syllabus will be in accordance with education qualification and experience as mentioned in the advertisement.

**d. Marks for Paper I:**

Each MCQ shall carry One mark for every correct answer. There is a Negative Marking of 1/3 marks for each incorrect / wrong answer.

**e. Qualifying Marks**

**Total Marks: 100 marks (One Hundred marks).**

(a) Candidates will have to score a total of 50% for General, 45% for OBC and 40% for SC/ST to qualify in the Theory Examination (Stage-I) to appear in Stage-II Physical Standards Test (PST) and if qualify then Stage-III Physical Efficiency Test (PET).

(b) The candidates who will qualify in Stage-I will only be called for Stage-II Test

**1.3 Physical Standards Test (PST)(Stage-II)**

**1.3.1 Nature of Examination**

This will be a qualifying eligibility Physical test for appearing in Stage-III and if qualify then for preparing the merit list.

**1.3.2 Type of Examination**

**a. Type of Test :**

There will be qualifying physical measurement test to whom each candidate has to possess the physical standards

**b. Qualifying physical measurement :**

The candidates who will qualify in Stage-II will only be called for Stage-III Tests. The qualifying physical measurement for Stage-II are as follows:

(i) For male Candidates	For Female Candidates
a) Height: 167 cms. Minimum (Relaxable by 5 cms only for residents of hill areas)	a) Height: 157 cms. Minimum (Relaxable by 2 cms only for residents of hill areas)
b) Chest: 80 cms minimum (76 cms. only for residents of hill	b) Not required

areas). **Minimum 5 cms expansion is required from Normal chest measurement for all.**

**Major hill areas-** Garhwal, Kumaon, Himachal Pradesh, Gorkhas, Dogras, Kashmir Valley, Leh & Ladakh regions of J&K, North-Eastern States and Sikkim).

To qualify physical Measurement test a candidate has to pass in all of the criteria.

#### 1.4 Physical Efficiency Test (PET)(Stage-III)

##### 1.3.1 Nature of Examination

This will be mark based qualifying Physical efficiency test.

##### 1.3.2 Type of Examination

###### a. Type of Test :

There will be qualifying physical efficiency test of 50 marks to whom each candidate has to qualify individually by securing minimum 25 marks (50% of the total marks).

###### b. Qualifying physical efficiency:

The candidates who will qualify in Stage-II will only be called for Stage-III Tests.

The qualifying physical efficiency parameters are as follows:

- Total qualifying marks will be 25 i.e. 50% of the total marks.**
- A candidate, who is not able to attain the minimum standards for any item, will be given zero marks for that.**
- Demonstrations, wherever required, will be shown.**

#### Preparation of Merit List

- a. All those candidates who will qualify in Stage -I Theory Examination will only be called for Stage-II Physical Standards Test (PST) and all those candidates who will qualify in Stage-II test will be called for Stage-III Physical Endurance Test (PET). Those candidates who will secure 25 or more marks (50% of total marks) will be considered qualify for PET.
- b. The merit will be prepared according to the marks obtained in the Stage -I Theory Examination and Stage-III Physical Efficiency Test. The Stage II test will only be qualifying examination.
- c. Tie cases (equal marks) will be resolved using.
  - (i) First by using date of birth with older candidates placed higher.
  - (ii) If not resolved by (i), the number of wrong answers / negative marks will be used wherein those with less wrong answers / negative marks will be placed higher.
