Scheme of Examination	<p><b>1.1 Overview of Scheme of Examination:</b></p> <p>(i) The Examination and Evaluation will be in two stages Stage-I: Online (CBT) mode Theory Examination with minimum qualifying marks for eligibility to appear in the Stage-II Examinations.</p> <p>(ii) Stage-II: Physical Standards Test (PST) with minimum qualifying physical eligibility parameters to appear in the Stage-II examination.</p> <p><b>1.2 Online (CBT) mode Theory Examination (Stage-I)</b></p> <p><b>1.2.1 Nature of Examination</b> This will be an eligibility examination for appearing in Stage-II and for preparing merit list.</p> <p><b>1.2.2 Language and mode of Examination</b> The MCQs will be in English language only.
