GENERAL INFORMATIONINTRODUCTION

An Act of Parliament in 1956 established the All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) as an autonomous institution of national importance and defined its objectives and functions. By virtue of this Act, the Institute awards its own medical degrees and other academic distinctions. The degrees awarded by the Institute under the All India Institute of Medical Sciences Act are recognized medical qualifications for the purpose of the Indian Medical Council Act and notwithstanding anything contained therein, are deemed to be included in the first schedule of that Act, entitling the holders to the same privileges as those attached to the equivalent awards from the recognized Universities of India.

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AIMS & OBJECTIVES

In the field of postgraduate education, the most important function of the Institute is to provide opportunities for training teachers for medical colleges in the country in an atmosphere of research and enquiry. Postgraduate students are exposed to newer methods of teaching and given opportunities to actively participate in teaching exercises. The other important objectives of the Institute are to bring together in one place educational facilities of the highest order for the training of personnel in all the important branches of health activity and to attain self-sufficiency in postgraduate medical education. The educational principles and practices being adopted are those which are best suited to the needs of the nation.

The online applications are invited from Indian Citizens as per Govt. of India's Residency Scheme, for the following posts of Senior Residents/Senior Demonstrators for the tenure period of 3 years. - Candidates may kindly take note that for the post of Senior Residents/Senior Demonstrators in the department of Anatomy, Biophysics, Biochemistry, Biotechnology and Pharmacology both Medical as well as Non-Medical candidates can apply.
- For other departments (except Medical Physics) only Medical candidates can apply.

- 2. ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS:
- i) For Medical Candidates (Senior Residents)

A postgraduate medical degree viz. MD/MS/MDS/DNB in the respective discipline from a recognized University/Institute/or equivalent qualification thereto.

a) For the Post of Geriatric Medicine

A Postgraduate medical degree viz. MD/DNB in Geriatric Medicine failing which MD/DNB in Medicine from a recognized university/Institute/ or equivalent qualification thereto.

b) For the post of Emergency Medicine & Casualty

A postgraduate medical degree viz. MD (Medicine) or MD (Emergency Medicine) or MD (Geriatric Medicine) or qualification recognized equivalent thereto in the discipline/subject.

c) For the post of Palliative Medicine

A postgraduate medical degree viz. MD/DNB in Palliative Medicine/Anesthesiology/Medicine/ Geriatrics Medicine/Oncology(Surgical/Medical/Radiation)

d) For the post of Plastic Surgery & Reconstructive Surgery

M.S./DNB Degree in Surgery/ENT/Orthopaedics from any University recognized by MCI.

e) For the post of Pulmonary Medicine

A Postgraduate medical degree viz. MD in Medicine, MD Pulmonary Medicine, MD Chest Medicine & MD Respiratory Medicine from a recognized University/Institute.

f) For Lab. Medicine

A postgraduate medical degree viz. MD in Laboratory Medicine / Pathology / Microbiology / Biochemistry from a recognized University/Institute.

g) Critical & Intensive Care

MD/DNB Degree in Anesthesiology or DM/DNB Degree in Critical Care Medicine from any University recognized by MCI.

- ii) For Non-Medical Candidates (Senior Demonstrators)
- I) For subjects of Anatomy, Biophysics, Biochemistry, Pharmacology & Biotechnology (Both medical as well as non-medical candidates can apply)
 - (a) The candidate should possess M.Sc./M. Biotech. Degree in the subject concerned and
 - (b) Ph.D. in the subject concerned/allied subject from a recognized University/Institute.
- II) For the posts of Senior Demonstrators in Medical Physics

M.Sc. in Medical Physics with one-year experience OR its equivalent recognized qualification OR M.Sc. in Physics with Diploma in Radiological Physics.

III) For the post of Senior Demonstrators in Biotechnology

M.Sc. in life Sciences (any subject) and Ph.D. in Life Science/ Biochemistry/Biophysics/ Biotechnology/Bioinformatics/Genetics/Microbiology OR MD in Biochemistry/Biophysics

(In the event any candidate possesses the qualification of M.Sc. with Ph.D., the pay scale will be similar to that of Non-Medical candidates with Ph.D.)

- 3 (i) To be eligible for selection for these posts, the candidate should pass the qualifying examination by 31.01.2019 & result should be declared to this effect on or before this date. The tenure of qualifying degree should also be completing latest by 31.01.2019.
 - (ii) Only those candidates who have been / are declared successful in their qualifying degree exam/viva i.e. DNB/MD/MS/Ph.D./M.Sc. (as applicable) and will be completing their tenure for the same on or before 31.01.2019 will be eligible to the considered for these posts.
 - (iii) In case of those who have appeared for exam / viva voce and result is yet to be declared then applicant will be allowed to appear in theory and/or interviewprovisionally.
 - (iv) In cases where result of qualifying exam. is declared after 31.01.2019, their candidature will stand cancelled and no claim for selection on the basis of theory exam and Interview allowed provisionally will be considered.
- 4. The candidates who are in service in any Govt. Hospital/ Institutions are required to submit their application through proper channel only. The candidates will not be permitted for Interview if they fail to produce no objection certificate on the day of interview during scrutiny of documents. They may be allowed provisionally only if they produce a certificate of informing to the HOD/Head of Organization of Institute in which they are employed.

If it is brought to the notice of authorities at any stage that the candidate had not submitted application through proper channel, then candidature will stand cancelled and in case of selected candidate, services will be terminated immediately.

- 5. UPPER AGE LIMIT (AS ON 31.01.2019)
 - a) The upper age limit for applying these posts are 37 years as on 31.01.2019. The maximum permissible relaxations are:

i)	SC/ST candidates	5 years

iii)	Persons with Bench-mark Disabilities [PWBD] General Category	10 years

b) The upper age limit for applying for the post of Senior Resident in Department of Hospital Administration are 40 years. The maximum permissible relaxations are:

i)	SC/ST candidates	5 years
ii)	OBC candidates	3 years
iii)	Persons with Bench-mark Disabilities [PWBD] General Category	10 years
iv)	Persons with Bench-mark Disabilities [PWBD] OBC Category	13 years
v)	Persons with Bench-mark Disabilities [PWBD] SC/ST Category	15 years

The upper age limit in case of Ex-serviceman and Commissioned Officers including ECOs/SSCOs/Government servants shall be relaxed by Five years' in addition to the relaxation in (a) & (b) above, subject to the condition that on the closing date for receipt of applications the continuous service rendered in the Armed Forces by an Ex-serviceman is not less than six months after attestation. This relaxation is also available to ECOs/SSCOs who have completed their initial period of assignment of five years of Military Service and whose assignment has been extended beyond five years as on closing date and in whose case the Ministry of Defence issues certificates that they will be released within 3 months on Selection from the date of receipt of offer of appointment. Candidates claiming age relaxation under this para would be required to produce a certificate in the prescribed proforma to the Commission at the time of Interview at AIIMS New Delhi.

NOTE: Ex-Serviceman who have already secured regular employment under the Central Govt. in a Civil Post are permitted the benefit of age relaxation as admissible for Ex-servicemen for securing another employment in any higher post or service under the Central Govt. However, such candidates will not be eligible for the benefit of reservation, if any for Ex-Servicemen in Central Govt. jobs.

6. PAYSCALES

- (i). For Medical candidates Rs.18,750+6600 (Grade Pay)+NPA plus other usual Allowances or revised pay scale as per 7th CPC as applicable. In the Pay of Level 11 of Pay Matrix (Pre-revised pay Band-3 with the entry Pay of Rs. 67700/-
- (ii). For Non-Medical candidates M.Sc. with Ph.D.Rs.16,740+5400 (Grade Pay) plus other usual Allowances.
- (iii). For post of Senior Demonstrators in Medical Physics, (those with M.Sc.) of Rs.12090 + 4200 (Grade Pay) plus other usual Allowance.

- 7. RESERVATION (For SC, ST & OBC & Persons with Bench-mark Disabilities [PWBD] Candidates):-
 - (i). Reservation has been provided in the above posts in accordance with Rules.
 - (ii). Reservation for Persons with Bench-mark Disabilities [PWBD] Candidates is 4% which will be provided on horizontal basis to Persons with Bench-mark Disabilities [PWBD] candidate in their respective categories.

Criteria for Persons with Bench-mark Disabilities [PWBD]:

The disability certificate should be issued by a duly constituted and authorized Medical Board of the State or Central Govt. Hospitals/Institutions and countersigned by Medical Superintendent /CMO/Head of Hospital/Institution.

* Candidate applying in OBC/SC/ST Category, must possess the caste certificate issued by competent authority, valid for admission/Job in Central Govt. Institutions issued before the date of interview (i.e. 17.12.2018), failing which he/she shall not be allowed to appear in interview for the same category. However, he/she can be treated as UR Candidate if in merit through online exam, subject to verification by Examination Section.

*OBC certificate must have been issued in last one year. <u>Date of validity of certificate shall be considered as 17.12.2018 (before the date of Interview)</u>.

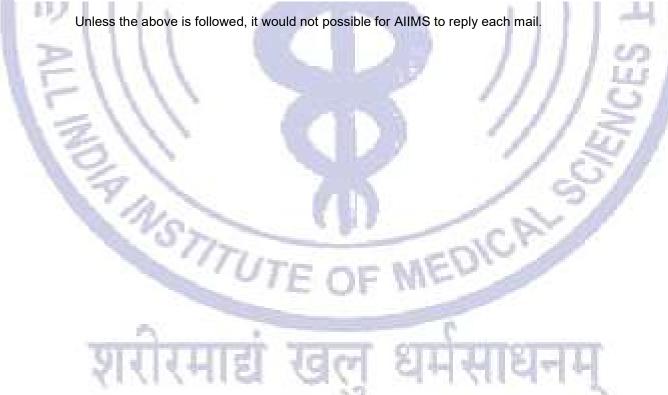

Criteria for Persons With Benchmark Disability [PWBD]

A SCHEDULE is annexed regarding, "SPECIFIED DISABILITY" clause (zc) of section 2, that states as under,

- 1. Physical disability
- A. Locomotor disability (a person's inability to execute distinctive activities associated with movement of self and objects resulting from affliction of musculoskeletal or nervous system or both), including—
 - (a) "leprosy cured person" means a person who has been cured of leprosy but is suffering from—
 - (i) loss of sensation in hands or feet as well as loss of sensation and paresis in the eye and eye-lid but with no manifest deformity;
 - (ii) manifest deformity and paresis but having sufficient mobility in their hands and feet to enable them to engage in normal economicactivity;
 - (iii) extreme physical deformity as well as advanced age which prevents him/her from undertaking any gainful occupation, and the expression "leprosy cured" shall construed accordingly;
 - (b) "cerebral palsy" means a Group of non-progressive neurological condition affecting body movements and muscle coordination, caused by damage to one or more specific areas of the brain, usually occurring before, during or shortly after birth;
 - (c) "dwarfism" means a medical or genetic condition resulting in an adult height of 4 feet 10 inches (147 centimeters) or less;
 - (d) "muscular dystrophy" means a group of hereditary genetic muscle disease that weakens the muscles that move the human body and persons with multiple dystrophy have incorrect and missing information in their genes, which prevents them from making the proteins they need for healthy muscles. It is characterized by progressive skeletal muscle weakness, defects in muscle proteins, and the death of muscle cells and tissue;
 - (e) "acid attack victims" means a person disfigured due to violent assaults by throwing of acid or similar corrosive substance.

B. Visual impairment—

- (a) "blindness" means a condition where a person has any of the following conditions, after best correction—
 - (i) total absence of sight; or
 - (ii) visual acuity less than 3/60 or less than 10/200 (Snellen) in the better eye with best possible correction; or 92
 - (iii) limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of less than 10 degree.
- (b) "low-vision" means a condition where a person has any of the following conditions, namely:
 - (i) visual acuity not exceeding 6/18 or less than 20/60 upto 3/60 or upto 10/200 (Snellen) in the better eye with best possible corrections; or
 - (ii) limitation of the field of vision subtending an angle of less than 40 degree up to 10 degrees.

C. Hearing impairment -

- (a) "deaf" means persons having 70 DB hearing loss in speech frequencies in both ears;
- (b) "hard of hearing" means person having 60 DB to 70 DB hearing loss in speech frequencies in both ears;
- D. "Speech and language disability" means a permanent disability arising out of conditions such as laryngectomy or aphasia affecting one or more components of speech and language due to organic or neurological causes.

- 2. Intellectual disability, a condition characterized by significant limitation both in intellectual functioning (reasoning, learning, problem solving) and in adaptive behavior which covers a range of every day, social and practical skills, including—
 - (a) "specific learning disabilities" means a heterogeneous group of conditions wherein there is a deficit in processing language, spoken or written, that may manifest itself as a difficulty to comprehend, speak, read, write, spell, or to do mathematical calculations and includes such conditions as perceptual disabilities, dyslexia, dysgraphia, dyscalculia, dyspraxia and developmental aphasia;
 - (b) "autism spectrum disorder" means a neuro-developmental condition typically appearing in the first three years of life that significantly affects a person's ability to communicate, understand relationships and relate to others, and is frequently associated with unusual or stereotypical rituals orbehaviors.
- 3. Mental behavior,— "mental illness" means a substantial disorder of thinking, mood, perception, orientation or memory that grossly impairs judgment, behavior, capacity to recognize reality or ability to meet the ordinary demands of life, but does not include retardation which is a condition of arrested or incomplete development of mind of a person,

specially characterized by sub normality of intelligence.

- 4. Disability caused due to-
 - (a) chronic neurological conditions, suchas—
 - (i) "multiple sclerosis" means an inflammatory, nervous system disease in which the myelin sheaths around the axons of nerve cells of the brain and spinal cord are damaged, leading to demyelination and affecting the ability of nerve cells in the brain and spinal cord to communicate with eachother;
 - (ii) "Parkinson's disease" means a progressive disease of the nervous system marked by tremor, muscular rigidity, and slow, imprecise movement, chiefly affecting middle-aged and elderly people associated with degeneration of the basal ganglia of the brain and a deficiency of the neurotransmitter dopamine.
 - (b) Blood disorder—
 - (i) "Haemophilia" means an inheritable disease, usually affecting only male but transmitted by women to their male children, characterized by loss or impairment of the normal clotting ability of blood so that a minor would may result in fatal bleeding;
 - (ii) "thalassemia" means a group of inherited disorders characterized by reduced or absent amounts of haemoglobin.
 - (iii) "sickle cell disease" means a hemolytic disorder characterized by chronic anemia, painful events, and various complications due to associated tissue and organ damage; "hemolytic" refers to the destruction of the cell membrane of red blood cells resulting in the release of hemoglobin.
- 5. Multiple Disabilities (more than one of the above specified disabilities) including deaf blindness which means a condition in which a person may have combination of hearing and visual impairments causing severe communication, developmental, and educational problems.
- 6. Any other category as may be notified by the Central Government.

Note: Any amendment to the Schedule to the RPWD Act, 2016, shall consequently stand amended in the above schedule.

The selection shall be subjected to medical fitness by Medical board.
